


Miramar Parkway Interchange Construction Update

Phase 2 construction of Miramar Parkway is currently underway as crews continue work in the middle bridge section. This phase is anticipated to be completed this summer.

Phase 3 construction will begin in the next few months. As part of this final phase, westbound traffic will be shifted onto the newly constructed middle bridge section. Crews will then demolish the westbound section of the existing bridge and will begin construction of the final section of the new bridge.

The final configuration will include three through lanes in the westbound and eastbound direction. In addition, there will be triple turning lanes from eastbound Miramar Parkway to I-75 northbound. Motorists on westbound Miramar Parkway will have triple turning lanes to I-75 southbound as well. The Miramar Parkway interchange is anticipated to be completed in early 2017.

<p align="center">SEGMENTS A & B</p> <p>NW 170 Street to South of Miramar Parkway Anticipated Completion: Fall 2018</p> <p>Upcoming activities: Construction crews continue building future Express Lanes within the existing median. A traffic shift is scheduled to occur on southbound I-75 from south of the Snake Creek Canal to Miami Gardens Drive. This traffic shift will allow crews to construct the new and permanent location for southbound I-75.</p>	<p align="center">SEGMENT C</p> <p>South of Miramar Parkway to South of Sheridan Street Anticipated Completion: Summer 2017</p> <p>Upcoming activities: Phase 2 construction of Miramar Parkway is currently underway and Phase 3 construction will begin in the next few months. Pembroke Road bridge is ongoing and is anticipated to be completed this summer. The contractor continues with drainage, toll facilities and sign structures construction activities in the median.</p>
<p align="center">SEGMENT D</p> <p>South of Sheridan Street to North of Griffin Road Anticipated Completion: Summer 2017</p> <p>Upcoming activities: Sheridan Street Interchange Phase 2 continues. Crews will construct the new pedestrian sidewalk on the north side of the bridge. Phase 3 construction will begin in June as crews demolish the south side of the bridge and begin construction of the new and final bridge portion.</p>	<p align="center">SEGMENT E</p> <p>North of Griffin Road to I-595 Anticipated Completion: Spring 2017</p> <p>Upcoming activities: The contractor continues building and paving the future Express Lanes in the existing median. Crews will also continue deck construction for a new bridge that will connect I-595 Express and 75 Express. The first entrance ramp from southbound I-75 (from Naples) to the eastbound 595 Express Lanes is scheduled to reopen this summer.</p>



General Project Overview

The 75 Express Lanes Project extends 15 miles along I-75 from NW 170 Street, in Miami Dade County, to I-595, in Broward County. Work will be completed in four segments. Construction began early 2014 and is scheduled to be completed by mid- 2019. The total project is estimated to cost \$481 million.

This project will complete another section of South Florida's managed lanes network for all motorists and will improve mobility, relieve congestion, provide additional travel options and accommodate future growth in the area.
