## **FDOT to Host Public Meeting for Roadway Project**

*75 Express Lanes Phase from South of Sheridan Street to North of Griffin Road to Begin*

**WESTON** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a public meeting to discuss the start of a roadway project at the third of four segments, Segment D, of the I-75 Express Lanes Project. The project limits extend along I-75 from South of Sheridan Street to North of Griffin Road, in Broward County.

The public meeting will be held **from 7:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. on Wednesday, August 27, 2014 at Ivanhoe Community Center 6101 SW 148 Avenue, Davie, FL 33330**. Attendees may arrive at any time from 7 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. A Power Point presentation will begin at 7:30 p.m. Graphic displays will be shown and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the project and answer questions after the formal presentation. The proposed work for this segment includes:

- Constructing Express Lanes in the existing median on I-75
- Constructing entrance and exit access points to the Express Lanes
- Constructing sound barrier walls along nine neighborhoods
- Widening the Sheridan Street Interchange
- Reconstructing the Sheridan Street Interchange
- Installing additional Traffic Cameras, Dynamic Message Signs and Toll Gantries
- Adding new signage, signals, lighting and landscaping

Segment D will cost \$80 million and work is scheduled to be completed by spring 2017. This work is part of the FDOT I-75 Express Lanes Project that extends 15 miles from NW 170 Street, in Miami-Dade County, to I-595, in Broward County. Work is scheduled to be completed by late 2018 and cost an estimated \$481 million.
