



CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Full Closures on Northbound Turnpike and I-75 Interchange Scheduled to Begin on Thursday, January 21

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to close all lanes on northbound Florida's Turnpike at the I-75 interchange to begin setting beams for the new Express Lanes bridges over Florida's Turnpike. In order to perform this work safely, traffic will be detoured during the following dates and times:

- **All lanes of northbound Florida's Turnpike at the I-75 interchange will be closed from 12:01 a.m. to 5 a.m. on Thursday, January 21 and Friday, January 22. Closures will continue nightly from 12:01 a.m. to 5 a.m. beginning Monday, January 25 through Wednesday, January 27. Motorists will be able to take the entrance ramp to northbound I-75 (Exit 39), exit at Miramar Parkway East (Exit 7A), continue eastbound on Miramar Parkway and then turn southbound on Red Road to re-enter northbound Florida's Turnpike. Please follow the posted detour.**

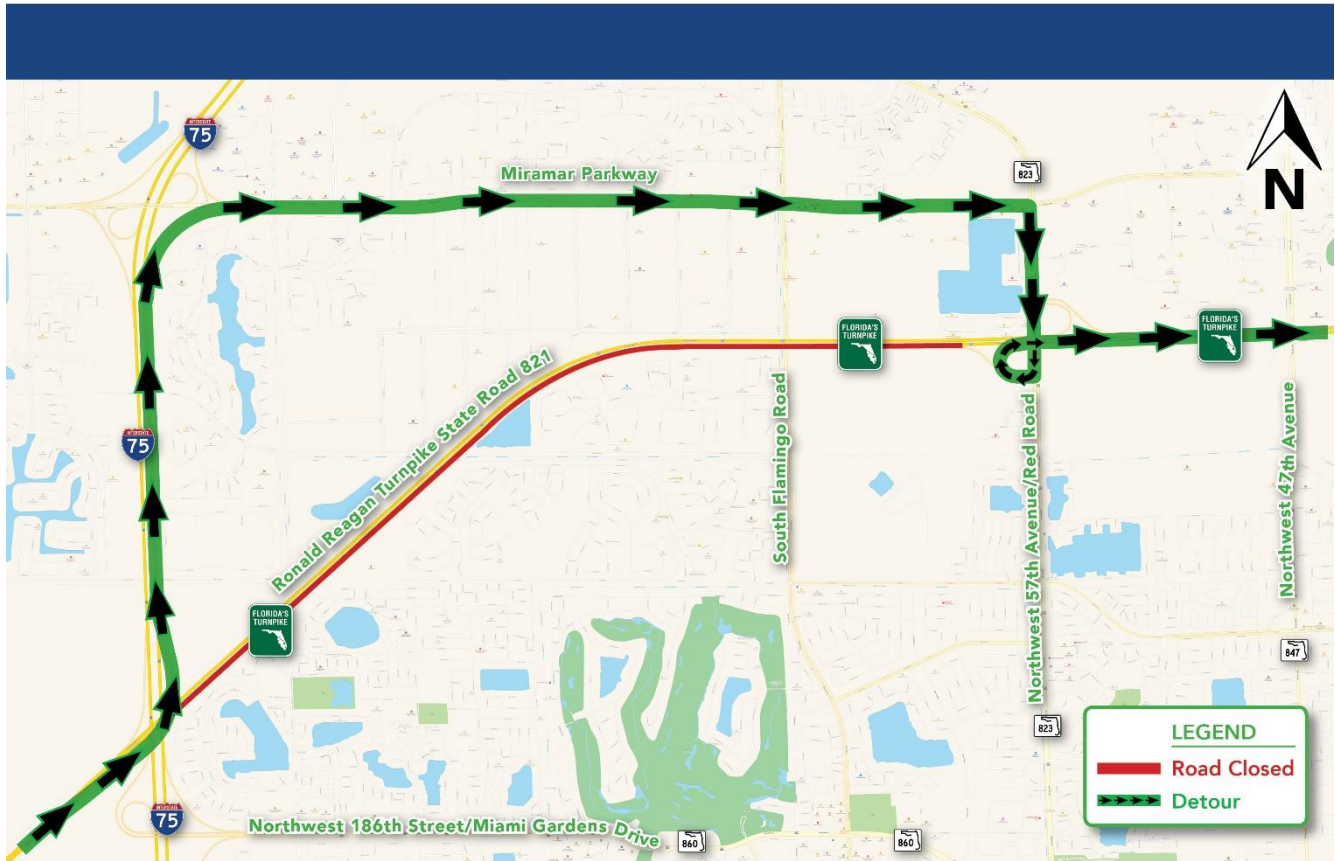
Please note that this schedule may change due to inclement weather or other unexpected conditions.
