



CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Full Closures on Northbound Turnpike and I-75 Interchange Scheduled to Begin on Monday, February 29

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to close all lanes on northbound Florida's Turnpike at the I-75 interchange to set beams for the new Express Lanes bridges over Florida's Turnpike. In order to perform this work safely, traffic will be detoured during the following dates and times:

- All lanes of northbound Florida's Turnpike at the I-75 interchange will be closed nightly from 12:01 a.m. to 5 a.m. beginning Monday, February 29 through Friday, March 4. Motorists will be able to take the entrance ramp to northbound I-75 (Exit 39), exit at Miramar Parkway East (Exit 7A), continue east on Miramar Parkway to NW 57 Avenue / Red Road and turn south on NW 57 Avenue / Red Road to re-enter northbound Florida's Turnpike. Please follow the posted detour.

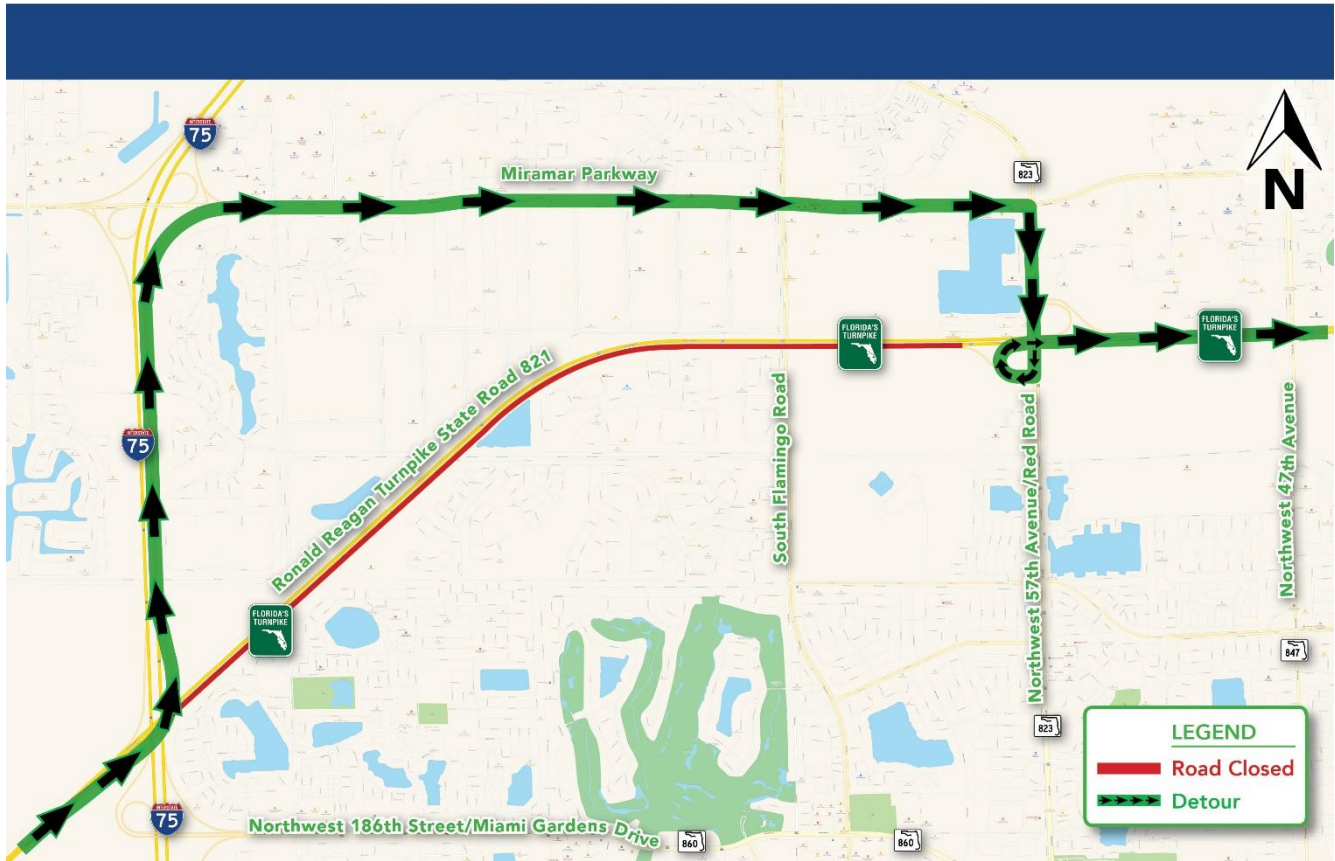
Please note that this schedule may change due to inclement weather or other unexpected conditions.
