



CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Full Closures on Northbound Florida's Turnpike at I-75 Interchange Scheduled to Begin Wednesday, November 30

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to close all northbound lanes along Florida's Turnpike at the I-75 Interchange to allow bridge construction of the new Express Lanes bridges over Florida's Turnpike. In order to perform this work safely, traffic will be detoured during the following dates and times:

All northbound lanes along Florida's Turnpike at the I-75 Interchange will be closed from 12 a.m. (midnight) Wednesday, November 30 to 5 a.m. Thursday, December 1. Motorists will be able to take the entrance ramp to northbound I-75 (Exit 39), exit at Miramar Parkway East (Exit 7A), continue east on Miramar Parkway to NW 57th Avenue / Red Road and south on NW 57th Avenue / Red Road to re-enter northbound Florida's Turnpike. Please follow the posted detour.

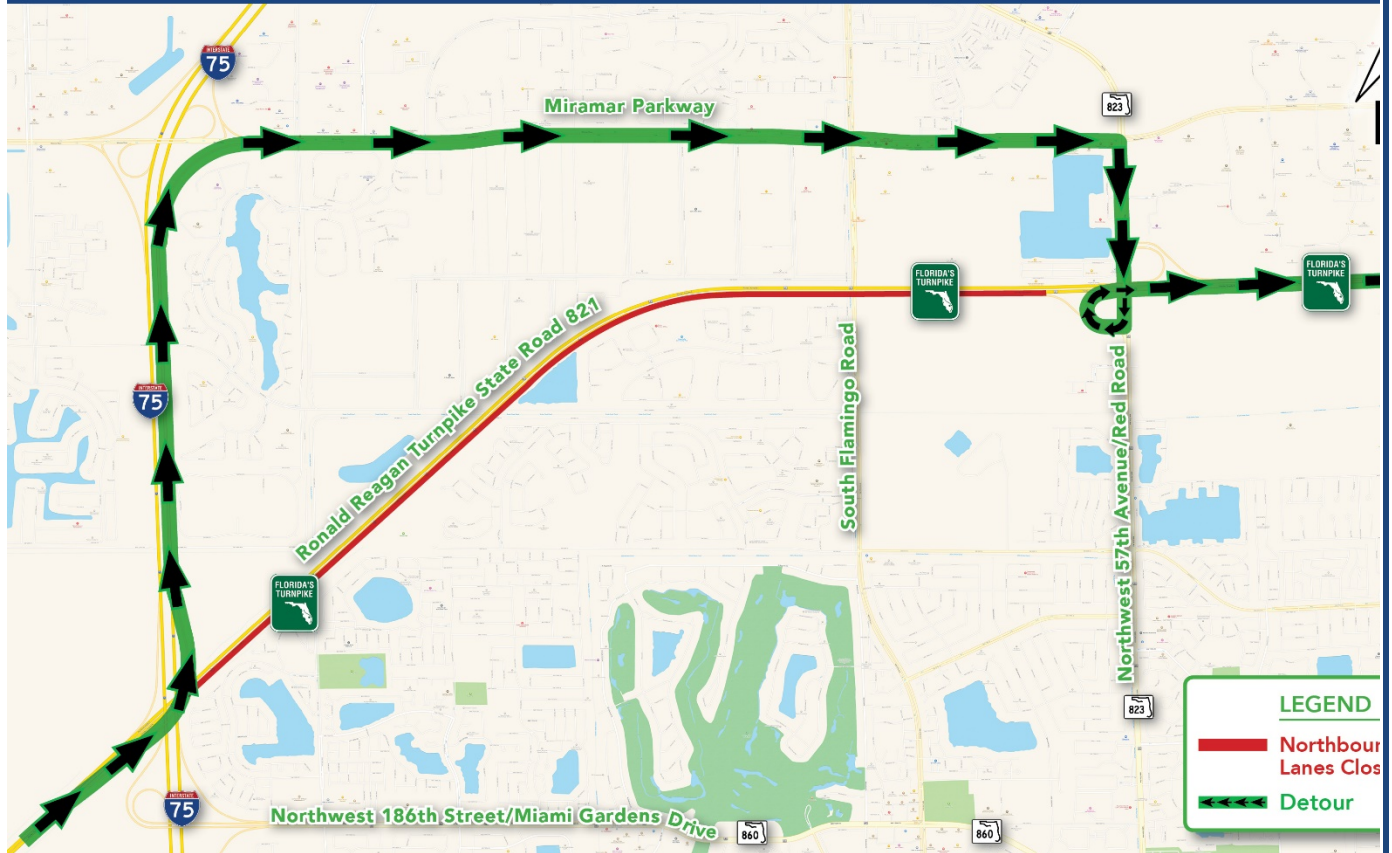
Please note that this schedule may change due to inclement weather or other unexpected conditions.
