



CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Full Closures on I-75 Northbound at Miramar Parkway Scheduled to Begin on Monday, October 19

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to close all northbound lanes along I-75 at Miramar Parkway to allow crews to continue setting overhead beams for the new Pembroke Road Bridge. In order to perform this work safely, traffic will be detoured during the following dates and times:

- All lanes of I-75 northbound at Miramar Parkway will be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. on Monday, October 19, Wednesday, October 21 and Tuesday, October 27.
 Motorists will be able to take the exit ramp at Miramar Parkway East (Exit 7A), continue eastbound to SW 145 Avenue, then north on SW 145 Avenue to Pines Boulevard and continue westbound on Pines Boulevard to re-enter northbound I-75.
 Motorists will also be able to take the exit ramp at Miramar Parkway West (Exit 7B), continue westbound to Dykes Road, then north on Dykes Road to Pines Boulevard and continue eastbound on Pines Boulevard to re-enter northbound I-75.
- If necessary to complete the work, these lane closures will also take place on Tuesday, October 20, Thursday, October 22 and Wednesday, October 28 from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Please note that this schedule may change due to inclement weather or other unexpected conditions.
