Segments A & B - I-75 from NW 170 to South of Miramar Parkway

- One southbound lane of Florida's Turnpike from Red Road to the I-75 Interchange will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. beginning Sunday, February 5 and ending Thursday, February 9.
- One northbound lane of Florida's Turnpike from I-75 Interchange to Red Road will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. beginning Sunday, February 5 and ending Thursday, February 9.
- One southbound lane of Florida's Turnpike from I-75 Interchange to Okeechobee Road will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. beginning Sunday, February 5 and ending Thursday, February 9.
- One northbound lane of Florida's Turnpike from Okeechobee Road to I-75 Interchange will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. beginning Sunday, February 5 and ending Thursday, February 9.
- One northbound ramp lane of Florida's Turnpike from Okeechobee Road to I-75 Interchange will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. beginning Sunday, February 5 and ending Thursday, February 9.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from Snake Creek Canal to Florida's Turnpike will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. beginning Sunday, February 5 and ending Thursday, February 9.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from NW 170 Street to Florida's Turnpike will be closed nightly from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. beginning Sunday, February 5 and ending Thursday, February 9.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from Florida's Turnpike to NW 170 Street will be closed nightly from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. beginning Sunday, February 5 and ending Thursday, February 9.

Segment C - I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to South of Sheridan Street in Broward County

- One northbound lane of I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to North of Miramar Parkway will be closed daily between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. for Miramar Parkway roadway construction.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to North of

Miramar Parkway will be closed daily between 11 a.m. and 3 p.m. for Miramar Parkway roadway construction.

- One northbound lane of I-75 from South of Pines Boulevard to North Pines Boulevard will be closed daily between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. for roadway construction.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from North of Pines Boulevard to South of Pines Boulevard will be closed daily between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. for roadway construction.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from South of Pines Boulevard to North of Pines Boulevard will be closed daily between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. for roadway construction.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from South of Pines Boulevard to North of Pines Blvd will be closed daily between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. for roadway construction.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from South of Pines Boulevard to North of Pines Boulevard will be closed nightly between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. for roadway construction.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from South of Pines Boulevard to North of Pines Boulevard will be closed nightly between 7 p.m. and 7 a.m. for roadway construction.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to North of Miramar Parkway will be closed nightly between 8 p.m. and 3 p.m. for bridge construction.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to North of Miramar Parkway will be closed daily between 10 a.m. and 7 a.m. for bridge construction.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed daily between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. for roadway construction.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed daily between 11 a.m. and 3 p.m. for bridge construction.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed nightly between 9 p.m. to 7 a.m. for roadway construction.

- One southbound lane of I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed nightly between 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. for roadway construction.
- One lane of Miramar Parkway, in both directions, from west of I-75 to east of I-75 will be closed nightly between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. for roadway construction.
- One eastbound lane of Miramar Parkway from west of I-75 to east of I-75 will be closed daily between 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. for bridge work.
- Two northbound lane of I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to North of Miramar Parkway will be closed nightly between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. for bridge work.
- All eastbound lanes along Miramar Parkway between Dykes Road and SW 148 Avenue will be closed from 11 p.m. Wednesday, February 8 to 5 a.m. Thursday, February 9. Motorist wanting to travel northbound on I-75 will be detoured at Dykes Road to continue northbound to Pines Boulevard then eastbound on Pines Boulevard to take the northbound entrance ramp to I-75. Motorist wanting to travel eastbound on Miramar Parkway will also be detoured to Pines Boulevard and continue eastbound on Pines Boulevard to Flamingo Road, then southbound on Flamingo Road to Miramar Parkway. Please follow the posted detour. If necessary to complete the work, these lane closures will also take place from 11 p.m. Thursday, February 9 to 5 a.m. Friday, February 10. **Please note, the southbound on ramp to I-75 from eastbound Miramar Parkway will remain open during this closure.*
- All westbound lanes along Miramar Parkway between SW 148 Avenue and Dykes Road will be closed from 11 p.m. Wednesday, February 8 to 5 a.m. Thursday, February 9. Motorist wanting to travel southbound on I-75 and westbound on Miramar Parkway will be detoured to travel northbound on I-75 and exit at Pines Boulevard West (Exit 9B), then take the southbound entrance ramp to I-75 and continue south towards Miramar Parkway. Please follow the posted detour. If necessary to complete the work, these lane closures will also take place from 11 p.m. Thursday, February 9 to 5 a.m. Friday, February 10.

**Segment D - I-75 from South of Sheridan Street to
North of Griffin Road**

- One northbound and one southbound lane of I-75 from South of Sheridan Street to North of Griffin Road may be closed on weekdays between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. as the contractor continues to work in this area.
- Two northbound or two southbound lanes of I-75 from South of Sheridan Street to North of Griffin Road will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. as the contractor continues to work in this area.
- One eastbound and one westbound lane of Sheridan Street may be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. as the contractor continues to work in this area.
- Two eastbound or two westbound lanes of Sheridan Street may be closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. as the contractor continues to work in this area.
- The ramp from northbound I-75 to westbound Sheridan Street may be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. beginning Sunday, February 5 and ending Thursday, February 9. Motorist will be detoured to take the exit ramp at Sheridan Street East (Exit 11A), continue eastbound on Sheridan Street then make a U-turn at Flamingo Road to continue westbound on Sheridan Street. Motorist should consider alternate routes using either Griffin Road or Pines Boulevard.
- The ramp from southbound I-75 to Sheridan Street East (Exit 11A) may be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. beginning Sunday, February 5 and ending Thursday, February 9. Motorists will be detoured to take the exit ramp at Sheridan Street West (Exit 11B), continue westbound on Sheridan Street then make a U-turn at Dykes Road to continue east on Sheridan Street.
- All westbound lanes on Sheridan Street, just east of the Sheridan Street bridge, will be closed from 11 p.m. Monday, February 6 to 5 a.m. Tuesday, February 7. Motorists traveling westbound on Sheridan Street will be detoured to make a U-Turn at NW 146 Avenue, go eastbound on Sheridan Street to Flamingo Road, northbound on Flamingo Road to Griffin Road and westbound on Griffin Road to take the entrance ramp to I-75 northbound/southbound. Please follow the posted detour. If necessary to complete the work, this closure will also take place Tuesday, February 7 through Friday, February 10 between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.

**Segment E - I-75 from North of Griffin Road to
I-595 in Broward County**

- One southbound lane of I-75 from south of Royal Palm Boulevard to South Post Road will be closed from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. beginning Monday February 6 and ending Tuesday, February 7.
- One eastbound lane of I-595 from west of Weston Road to east of Weston Road will be closed from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. beginning Wednesday February 8 and ending Thursday, February 9.

**Northbound Lane Balancing Project from Indian Trace
to I-595 in Broward County**

- Two northbound lanes of I-75 from North of Indian Trace along northbound Sawgrass Expressway (SR 869) and eastbound I-595 ramp will be closed nightly from 9:00 p.m. to 6:30 a.m. beginning Sunday, February 5 and ending Thursday, February 9.
- Three northbound lanes of I-75 from North of Royal Palm Boulevard to I-595 entrance ramp will be closed daily from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. beginning Sunday, February 5 and ending Thursday, February 9.
- Three northbound lanes of I-75 from North of Royal Palm Boulevard to North of Indian Trace will be closed daily from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. beginning Sunday, February 5 and ending Thursday, February 9.
- Two northbound lanes of I-75 from North of Royal Palm Boulevard to I-595 entrance ramp will be closed nightly from 9:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. beginning Sunday, February 5 and ending Thursday, February 9.
- Two northbound lanes of I-75 from North of Royal Palm Boulevard to North of Indian Trace will be closed nightly from 9:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. beginning Sunday, February 5 and ending Thursday, February 9.
