- One southbound lane of Florida's Turnpike from I-75 Interchange to Okeechobee will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. beginning Sunday, October 30 and ending Thursday, November 3.
- One northbound lane of Florida's Turnpike from Okeechobee to I-75
 Interchange will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. beginning Sunday,

- One northbound lane of I-75 from South of Pines Boulevard to North of Pines Boulevard will be closed on daily between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. for bridge construction.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from South of Pines Boulevard to North of Pines Boulevard will be closed on daily between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. for bridge construction.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from South of Pines to North of Pines Boulevard will be closed daily between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. for bridge construction.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from South of Pines Boulevard to North of Pines Boulevard will be closed on nightly between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. for bridge construction.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from South of Pines to North of Pines Boulevard will be closed nightly between 7 p.m. and 7 a.m. for bridge construction.
- One northbound lane of I-75 South of Miramar Parkway to North of Miramar Parkway will be closed on nightly between 8 p.m. and 3 p.m. for bridge construction.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to North of Miramar Parkway will be closed daily between 10 a.m. and 7 a.m. for bridge construction.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed daily between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. for bridge construction.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed nightly between 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. for bridge construction.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed nightly between 9 p.m. and 7 a.m. for bridge construction.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from South of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed daily between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. for bridge construction.

Segment D - I-75 from South of Sheridan Street to

North of Griffin Road

- One northbound and one southbound lane of I-75 from South of Sheridan Street to North of Griffin Road may be closed on weekdays between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. as the contractor continues to work in this area.
- Two northbound or two southbound lanes of I-75 from South of Sheridan Street to North of Griffin Road will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. as the contractor continues to work in this area.
- One eastbound and one westbound lane of Sheridan Street may be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. as the contractor continues to work in this area.
- Two eastbound or two westbound lanes of Sheridan Street may be closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. as the contractor continues to work in this area.
- The ramp from northbound I-75 to westbound Sheridan Street may be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. beginning Sunday, October 30 and ending Thursday, November 3. Motorist will be detoured to take the exit ramp at Sheridan Street East (Exit 11A), continue eastbound on Sheridan Street then make a U-turn at Flamingo Road to continue westbound on Sheridan Street. Motorist should consider alternate routes using either Griffin Road or Pines Boulevard.
- The ramp from southbound I-75 to Sheridan Street East (Exit 11A) may be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. beginning Sunday, October 30 and ending Thursday, November 3. Motorists will be detoured to take the exit ramp at Sheridan Street West (Exit 11B), continue westbound on Sheridan Street then make a U-turn at Dykes Road to continue east on Sheridan Street.

<u>Segment E - I-75 from North of Griffin Road to</u> <u>I-595 in Broward County</u>

- Two lanes of northbound I-75, North of Indian Trace will be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. beginning Sunday, October 30 and ending Thursday, November 3.
- Two lanes of eastbound I-595 just before SW 136 Avenue will be closed nightly from 7 p.m. to 4a.m. beginning Sunday, October 30 and ending Thursday, November 3.
- Two lanes from southbound I-75 (from Naples) at the I-595 interchange will be closed nightly from 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. beginning Sunday, October 30 and ending Thursday, November 3.
- One lanes of southbound I-75 from North of Indian Trace to North of Royal Palm Boulevard will be closed nightly from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. beginning Sunday, October 30 and ending Thursday, November 3.
- Two lanes of southbound Sawgrass, North of the I-595 interchange will be closed nightly from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. beginning Sunday, October 30 and ending Thursday, November 3.
- Two northbound lanes of Sawgrass Expressway at the I-595 interchange will be closed nightly from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. beginning Sunday, October 30 and ending Thursday, November 3.
- One lane of the ramp from westbound I-595 to southbound I-75 will be closed nightly from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. beginning Sunday, October 30 and ending Thursday, November 3.
- One lane of westbound SR 84 from Flamingo Road to SW 136 Avenue will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. beginning Sunday, October 30 and ending Thursday, November 3.
- Two lanes of northbound I-75, North of South Post Road, will be closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. beginning Sunday, October 30 and ending Thursday, November 3.
- Two lanes of northbound I-75, North of Indian Trace may be closed nightly from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. beginning Sunday, October 30 and ending Thursday, November 3.

Segment E - I-75 Northbound Lane Balancing Project

- Two northbound lanes of I-75 from North of Royal Palm Boulevard to North of Indian Trace will be closed daily from 9:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. beginning Sunday, October 30 and ending Thursday, November 3.
- Two northbound lanes of I-75 from North of Royal Palm Boulevard to I-595 entrance ramp will be closed daily from 9:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. beginning Sunday, October 30 and ending Thursday, November 3.
- Three northbound lanes of I-75 from North of Royal Palm Boulevard to North of Indian Trace will be closed nightly from 7:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. a.m. beginning Sunday, October 30 and ending Thursday, November 3.
- Three northbound lanes of I-75 from North of Royal Palm Boulevard to I-595 entrance ramp will be closed nightly from 7:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. beginning Sunday, October 30 and ending Thursday, November 3.
- Two northbound lanes of I-75 from North of Indian Trace along northbound Sawgrass Expressway (SR 869) and eastbound I-595 ramp will be closed nightly from 9:00 p.m. to 6:30 a.m. beginning Sunday, October 30 and ending Thursday, November 3.
- Two northbound lanes of I-75 from North of Royal Palm to I-595 will be closed nightly will be closed daily from 9:00 p.m. to 6:30 a.m. beginning Sunday, October 30 and ending Thursday, November 3.
- All northbound lanes of I-75 from North of Royal Palm Boulevard to west of the Sawgrass Expressway will be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. beginning Sunday, October 30 and ending Thursday, November 3. Motorists will be detoured to exit at Royal Palm Boulevard (Exit 15), continue west on Royal Palm Boulevard, go north on Weston Road to SR 84, then west on SR 84 to enter I-75 northbound. Please follow the posted detour. *Please note, I-75 northbound to Sawgrass Expressway northbound and I-595 eastbound will remain open during this closure.
