



75 Express Traffic Report – 01/11/19 – 01/18/19

Segments A & B - I-75 from NW 170 to South of Miramar Parkway

- One southbound lane of I-75 just south of Bass Creek Bridge will be closed from 12 a.m. to 8 a.m. Friday, January 11.
- One lane in each direction of I-75 from NW 170 Street to Florida's Turnpike may be closed Friday, January 11 through Thursday, January 17. The northbound lane may be closed from 8 p.m. to 4 p.m., and the southbound lane may be closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from Miami Gardens Drive to NW 170 Street will be closed Sunday, January 13 through Thursday, January 17 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Two northbound lanes of I-75 from Florida's Turnpike to Snake Creek Canal may be closed Sunday, January 13 through Thursday, January 17 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Two lanes in each direction of I-75 from Florida's Turnpike to NW 170 Street may be closed Sunday, January 13 through Thursday, January 17 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and or 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- One lane in each direction of Florida's Turnpike from Red Road to the I-75 Interchange will be closed Sunday, January 13 through Thursday, January 17 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- One lane in each direction of Florida's Turnpike from I-75 Interchange to Okeechobee Road will be closed Sunday, January 13 through Thursday, January 17 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- One ramp lane of I-75 from Florida's Turnpike from Okeechobee Road to I-75 Interchange may be closed Sunday, January 13 through Thursday, January 17 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

- One lane in each direction of I-75 from Snake Creek Canal to Florida's Turnpike may be closed nightly Sunday, January 13 through Thursday, January 17 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Two southbound lanes of I-75 from Miami Gardens Drive to Florida's Turnpike on-ramp may be closed Sunday, January 13 through Thursday, January 17 from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Two lanes in each direction of I-75 from Florida's Turnpike to Miramar Parkway may be closed Sunday, January 13 through Thursday, January 17 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Two lanes in each direction of I-75 from Florida's Turnpike to Miami Gardens Drive may be closed nightly Sunday, January 13 through Thursday, January 17 from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- One lane in each direction of I-75 at Florida's Turnpike may be closed Sunday, January 13 through Thursday, January 17 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Two southbound lanes of I-75 from Miramar Parkway to Miami Gardens may be closed Sunday, January 13 through Thursday, January 17 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and or 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Two lanes in each direction of I-75 from Snake Creek Canal to Miami Gardens Drive may be closed Sunday, January 13 through Thursday, January 17 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and or 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Two lanes in each direction of I-75 from Miramar Parkway to NW 170 Street may be closed Sunday, January 13 through Thursday, January 17 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and or 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- One northbound and one southbound express lanes from north of Miramar Parkway to south of NW 170 Street will be closed continuously beginning 9 a.m. Thursday, January 17 until 9 a.m. Saturday, January 19.
- The northbound ramp of I-75 from Florida's Turnpike northbound (EXIT 39) will be closed 11 p.m. Wednesday, January 16 until 5 a.m. Thursday, January 17. During this closure, motorists wishing to take the I-75 northbound ramp from Florida's Turnpike northbound (Exit 39) will be detoured to exit at US 27/Okeechobee Road (Exit 35), continue south on US 27/Okeechobee Road to NW 138 Street, and east on NW 138 Street to Hialeah Gardens Boulevard to take the northbound entrance ramp to I-75. If necessary to complete the work, this closure will also take place 11 p.m. Thursday, January 17 until 5 a.m. Friday, January 18.
